Ready-to-eat food means food that is ordinarily consumed in the same as that in which it is sold and does not include nuts totally enclosed in the shell or whole fruit and vegetables intended for further processing by the customer.

Potentially Hazardous Foods (PHF) are foods that require time-temperature control to keep them safe for human consumption.
