## Re: Construction of shared path to start Wednesday 10 March

Dear resident,

As part of the Active Travel Plan, Wagga Wagga City Council plan to start works to construct a shared path between Avocet Drive and Gardiner Street from Wednesday 10 March 2021. Work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and is expected to take approximately two weeks to complete, weather permitting.

A detailed design is on the reverse of this page for your reference.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents. We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.

Council has constructed 14km of the 45km network of dedicated shared paths. When complete the links will criss-cross the city and provide residents with a safe, alternative transport option for commuting. The project will link the outer suburbs with the central business area.

The \$12.8M project is funded by the NSW Government and Wagga Wagga City Council.
