Notice to residents

Re: Temporary closure of parking spaces on Beckwith Street from March 2021

Dear Resident,

As part of the Active Travel Plan, Wagga Wagga City Council will construct a new 2.5m wide asphalt shared path on Beckwith Street.

Work is expected to start mid-March and will be carried out between 7am and 5pm, weather permitting.

Line marking for the new parking lane will be carried out as a separate works package. During this period existing parking spaces will be temporarily closed, and residents will be asked to park their vehicles elsewhere until line marking is complete.

The path will run along the existing roadway and be separated from the flow of traffic by a rubber kerb.

To assist in the efficiency of this project please ensure all vehicles are parked off or across the street prior to start of works.

Council has constructed 14km of the network of dedicated shared paths under the Active Travel Plan project. When complete the links will criss-cross the city and provide residents with a safe, alternative transport option for commuting. The project will link the outer suburbs with the central business area.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents.

We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.
