Re: Construction of commuter cycling network - Stage 1

Dear Resident.

The purpose of this letter is to advise that a 2.5 metre wide asphalt shared path will be constructed along the Travers Street nature strip between Beckwith Street and Narrung Street. Please refer to attached maps. Work will be carried out from Monday 22 February between 7am and 6pm, weather permitting. The project is expected to be completed by the end of June 2021.

Council has constructed 14km of the network of dedicated shared paths under the Active Travel Plan project. When complete the links will criss-cross the city and provide residents with a safe, alternative transport option for commuting. The project will link the outer suburbs with the central business area.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents. We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.


