## **Re: Construction of commuter cycling network – Kapooka Link**

Dear resident,

The purpose of this letter is to advise that a cycleway will be constructed within the vicinity of your property, from Red Hill Road along Mima Street (south of the rail corridor) to Fernleigh Road finishing at Pinaroo Drive. A detailed design is on the reverse of this page. Work will be carried out from Monday 22 February between 7am and 6pm, weather permitting. The project is expected to be completed by the end of June 2021.

In January 2018, after extensive community consultation and planning, the NSW Government announced funding to allow Wagga Wagga City Council to plan, design and implement Council's Active Travel Plan (ATP) project.

Council has constructed 14km of the 45km network of dedicated shared paths. When complete the links will criss-cross the city and provide residents with a safe, alternative transport option for commuting. The project will link the outer suburbs with the central business area.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents. We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.

The \$12.8M project is funded by the NSW Government and Wagga Wagga City Council.
