Re: Construction of commuter cycling network - University Link

Dear resident,

Further to our previous correspondence dated 14 May 2020, please be advised that a cycleway will be constructed within the vicinity of your property, from Harris Road in Gobbagombalin through Estella to Boorooma Street. A detailed design is attached for your reference.

Work will start Monday 15 February 2021, and be carried out between 7am and 6pm, weather permitting. The project is expected to be completed by the end of June 2021.

The existing path behind residences on Doman Street (between Gunn Drive and Boorooma Street) will be closed intermittently in sections to allow for construction activities.

Section 1 – Gunn Drive to Pugsley Avenue

Section 2 - Gunn Drive to Pine Gully Road

Section 3 – Pugsley Avenue to Boorooma Street

Section 4 - Harris Road

Harris Road will also undergo work to produce an aesthetically pleasing community asset with an extended lifespan, in line with the aims of the Active Travel Plan project. The existing road will undergo cutting and milling to produce the required high-quality 3m wide thoroughfare, with landscaping work to follow in the coming months.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents. We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.

In January 2018, after extensive community consultation and planning, the NSW Government announced funding to allow Wagga Wagga City Council to plan, design and implement Council's Active Travel Plan (ATP) project.

Council has constructed 14km of the 45km network of dedicated shared paths. When complete the links will criss-cross the city and provide residents with a safe, alternative transport option for commuting. The project will link the outer suburbs with the central business area.

The \$12.8M project is funded by the NSW Government and Wagga Wagga City Council.




Detailed Design – Overview
