Re: Construction of end of trip facilities

Dear Resident,

Further to our previous correspondence dated 15 October 2020, please be advised construction has now started on the end of trip facilities near the Visitor Information Centre in Tarcutta Street and the Oasis Regional Aquatic Centre in Morgan Street.

The \$297K project is scheduled for completion at the end of June, weather permitting.

Works will be carried out between 7am and 5pm, Monday to Friday. During construction hours there will be an increase in heavy vehicle movements and noise however every effort will be made to minimise the impact on residents.

Location of facilities





The facilities will enhance the Active Travel cycleway network and support people who want to cycle to work into the central business district. It will encourage the community to use non-motorised transport and help promote a healthy lifestyle to a more active community with a reduced reliance on cars.

The works will include a toilet and shower area, CCTV lighting, wall mounted bike racks, enclosed bike lockers, bicycle maintenance station, e-bike charging stations and a water drinking station. The lockable facility will have electronic swipe card access.

We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate the patience of residents and road users.
