Re: Construction of commuter cycling network to start 19 October.


Dear resident,

Wagga Wagga City Council delivered a letter in May 2020 advising that the construction of the city's 45 km Active Travel Cycleway would start in June and the works were to be carried out along numerous links across the city.


Works for the Koorungal Link will take place along Koorungal Road (between Lake Albert Road and Vincent Road) from Monday 19 October. The work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and is expected to be completed by the end of November, 2020, weather permitting.

The Active Travel Plan project will provide a 45km cycleway network linking residential parts of the city with the CBD and other key destinations, such as Charles Sturt University and Kapooka.
