
NOTICE TO VISITORS

Re: Construction of shared path to start Monday 8 March 2021

As part of the Active Travel Plan, Wagga Wagga City Council will be carrying out works to construct a shared path between Gardiner Street and Hampden Avenue, North Wagga from Monday 8 March 2021. Work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm from Monday to Friday and will take approximately 3 weeks to complete, weather permitting.



Council has constructed 14km of the 45km network of dedicated shared paths. When complete the links will criss-cross the city and provide residents with a safe, alternative transport option for commuting. The project will connect the outer suburbs with the central business area.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but every effort will be made to minimise the impact on visitors to the park. We apologise for any inconvenience this work may cause and appreciate your patience.

The \$12.8M project is funded by the NSW Government and Wagga Wagga City Council.
