Notice to the resident – Works on Old Narrandera Road and Pine Gully Road

Weather permitting, the project to upgrade a section of Old Narrandera Road and a section of Pine Gully Road will start on Tuesday 8 August 2023.

Work will be carried out between 7am and 6pm, Monday to Saturday.

The project aims to improve safety and traffic flow. It forms part of Pine Gully Road Corridor Works servicing the residents of Gobbagombalin, Estella and Charles Sturt University.

This project will increase the road's capacity to accommodate both the present and future traffic demands in the area.

The upgrade includes:

- reconstructing pavement of Old Narrandera Road from a point approximately 100m west of the Olympic Highway intersection to, and including, the Pine Gully Road intersection
- adding an extra lane in each direction of Old Narrandera Road between Olympic Highway and Pine Gully Road
- creating a dedicated right turn onto Pine Gully Road from Old Narrandera Road
- creating a channelised T-intersection with a left turn slip lane out of Pine Gully Road onto Old Narrandera Road
- reconstructing approximately 100m of Pine Gully Road pavement from the Old Narrandera Road intersection
- improving drainage by replacing culverts and constructing table drains
- installing new signage, concrete medians and guardrails.

Road and lane closures

There will be some disruption for road users during this upgrade, with a temporary speed limit reduction, intermittent road closures with detours along with lane closures in place at different stages of the project.

Traffic disruptions including road and lane closures will change every two to five days.

We recommend planning your trips and allowing extra travel time as there will be delays and detours in place during the various phases of the works.
