

Disclosures by Councillors and Designated Persons Return

Request for Personal Information to be Redacted

The Government Information (Public Access) Act (GIPA Act) requires Council to keep a register of all annual Disclosures by Councillors and Designated Persons Return published on Council's Website.

The GIPA Act allows Councillors and designated staff to request that certain personal information be redacted from the annual return before being made public. These requests will be assessed by the General Manager.

Personal information may include your home address, your signature, sources of income, interests in corporations, debts and information relating to family members.

If you wish personal information contained in your return to be redacted before it is posted on Council's website, please complete the below and return it to the Governance Team along with your completed Annual Return either by email - SGOV-ARGD@wagga.nsw.gov.au or by hand.
