



WOLLUNDRY LAGOON PRECINCT

Baylis Street & Morrow Street, Wagga Wagga NSW 2650

The Wollundry Lagoon Precinct and Amphitheatre are set against the beautiful backdrop of the Wollundry Lagoon and provide a great area for a variety of outdoor events. Located in the city centre the site consists of multiple lawns and a stepped amphitheatre. Limited established trees within the event spaces give a small amount of shade, with most of the shade available on the lawn bordering Tarcutta Street.

Vehicle access to site from Burns Way. The large lawn bordering Tarcutta Street has an additional dropped kerb access point directly off Tarcutta Street. Site boundaries are unfenced.
