

Minimum Conditions for a Road Underbore

- The road shall be under bored, directional drilled with a tolerance of 10mm between bore hole and sleeve. On occasions when this tolerance cannot be met (wet or rocky ground) cement grouting will be required.
- Sleeving shall extend to a minimum of 1.2 m beyond the property line.
- Owner guarantees to maintain service and markers and insure council against any residual liability of the pipeline.
- The owner checks “dial before you dig”.
- Service to be clearly marked with permanent markers, both concrete blocks and marker posts on road boundary or at changes in direction. The service shall to be laid in a straight line and at constant grade between markers and at 90 degrees to the road.
- Provision of a work as executed drawing shall be provided with GPS locations and depth markers noted.
- The minimum depth of cover shall be 1.0m under table drain and all other points in the Road Reserve.
